Write up on the target and achievement of the Agriculture Section of the Directorate of Economics & Statistics for the year 2019-20.

1. General Crop Estimation Survey: Under this scheme, the Agriculture section is conducting Crop Cutting Experiment (CCE) on thirteen crops annually. The crops covered under CCE are winter paddy, autumn paddy, jhum paddy, spring paddy, ginger, summer potato, winter potato, rapeseed & mustard, maize, wheat, jute, cotton and turmeric. The methodology adopted for the survey is the scientific methodology developed by the Indian Agricultural Statistics Research Institute, Pusa. The CCE on these crops for the year 2019-20 is in progress in all the districts and the reports are yet to be received from the Districts.

During the year 2018-19, this section has conducted CCE on the following number of crops.

- 2. National Agricultural Insurance Scheme: Under this scheme, the Agriculture section is responsible for furnishing the yield data on all the insured crops of the State to the Insurance Company for settlement of the insurance claims of the farmers. The insured crops for the year 2018-19 are winter paddy, autumn paddy, spring paddy, ginger, maize, rabi potato, kharif potato, turmeric and rapeseed & mustard and the yield data on all these crops has been furnished to the departments concerned as per requirement.
- State Level Crop Report, Land Use Statistics and Irrigation Statistics: The Agriculture section also compiles the State Level Crop Report, Land Use Statistics and Irrigation Statistics annually. The report for the year 2018-19 is under reconciliation with the concerned departments.
