MEGHALAYA AT A GLANCE

Physical Features :—

Meghalaya is the 21st State of India. It was carved out of the Assam State. It first emerged as an Autonomous State within Assam, on the 2nd April, 1970 and then a full-fledged State with effect from the 21st, January, 1972.

It is bounded on the north by the districts of Kamrup, Goalpara and Karbi Anglong of Assam State; on the south and on the west by Bangla Desh and on the east by the districts of Cachar and North Cachar Hills also of the State of Assam.

Meghalaya lies between $25^{\circ}47'N$ to $26^{\circ}10'N$ latitude and $89^{\circ}45'E$ to $92^{\circ}47'E$ longitude.
