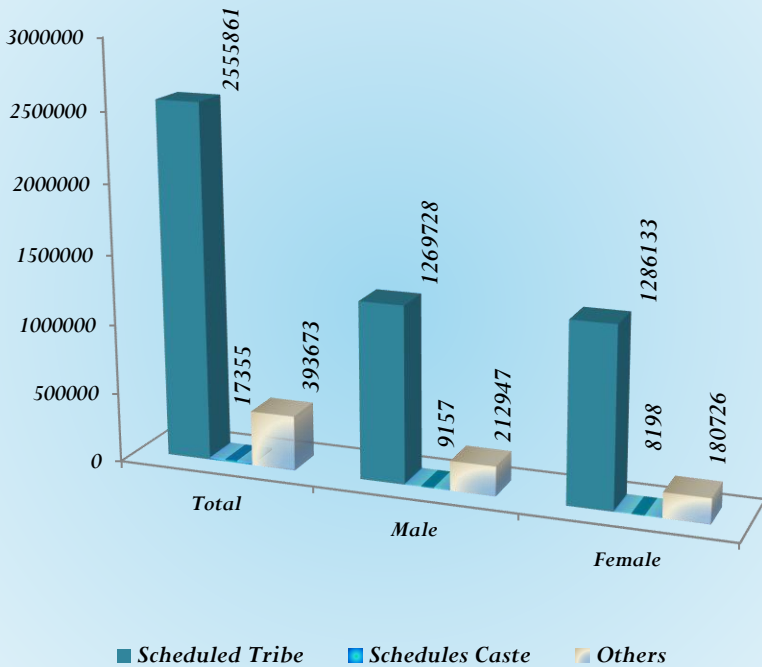

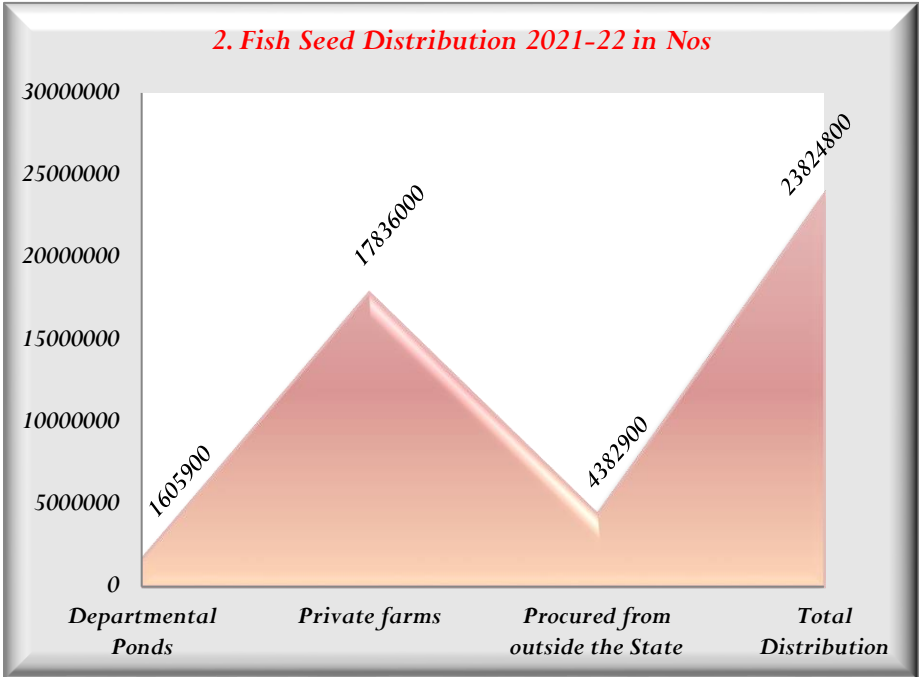

2. Fish Seed Distribution 2021-22 in Nos



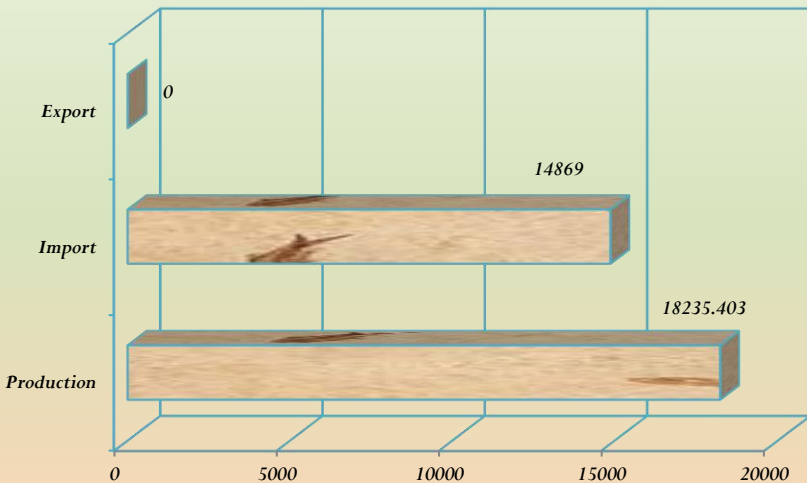

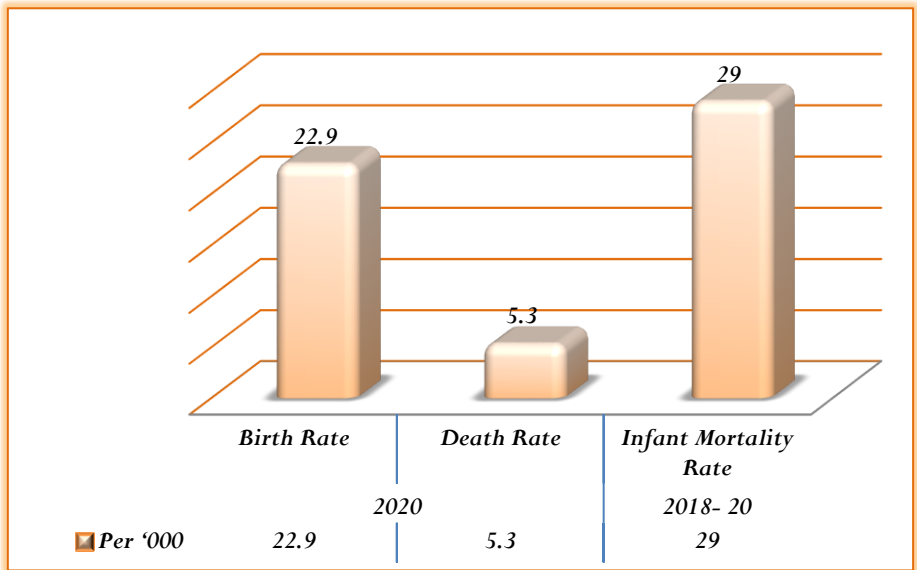
**5. Student Enrollment by Level & Gender

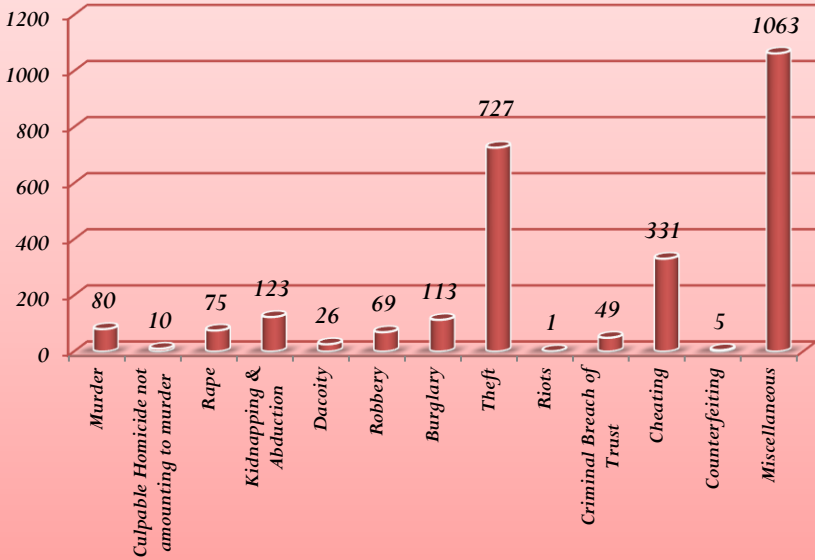

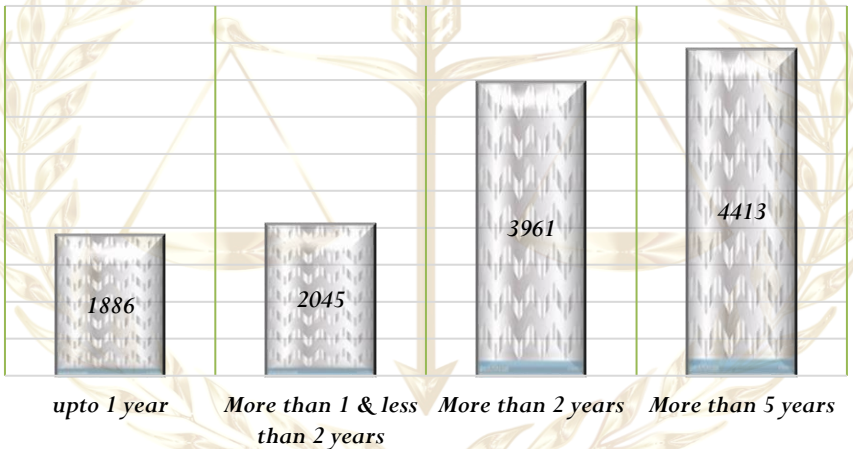

4. Bifurcation of Criminal Pending cases in the Sub-Ordinate Courts under Meghalaya High Court for the year 2021.

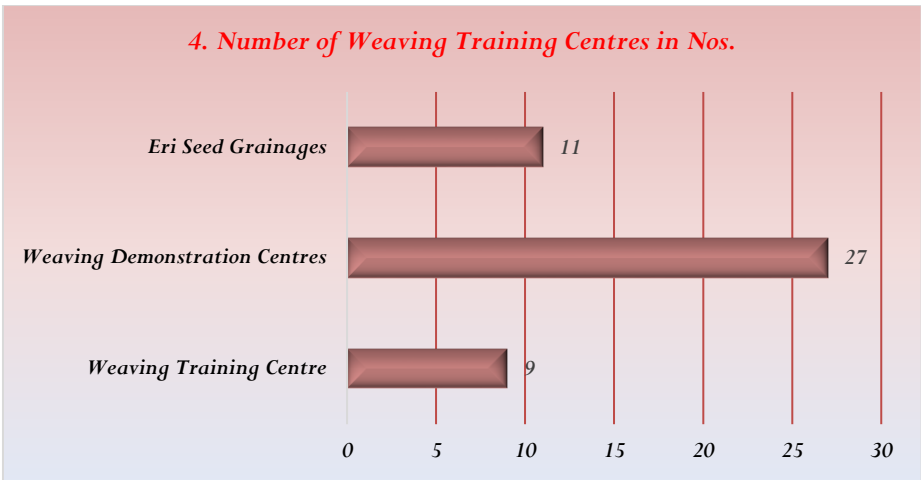

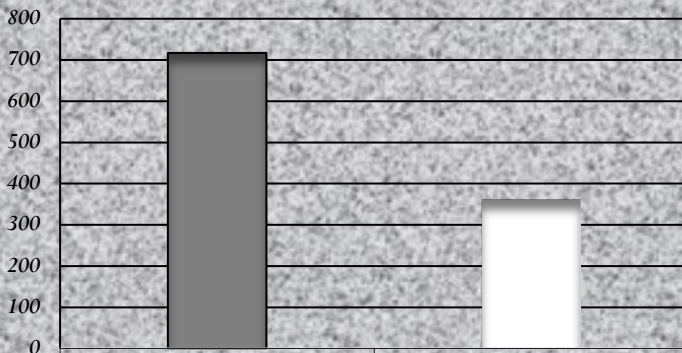

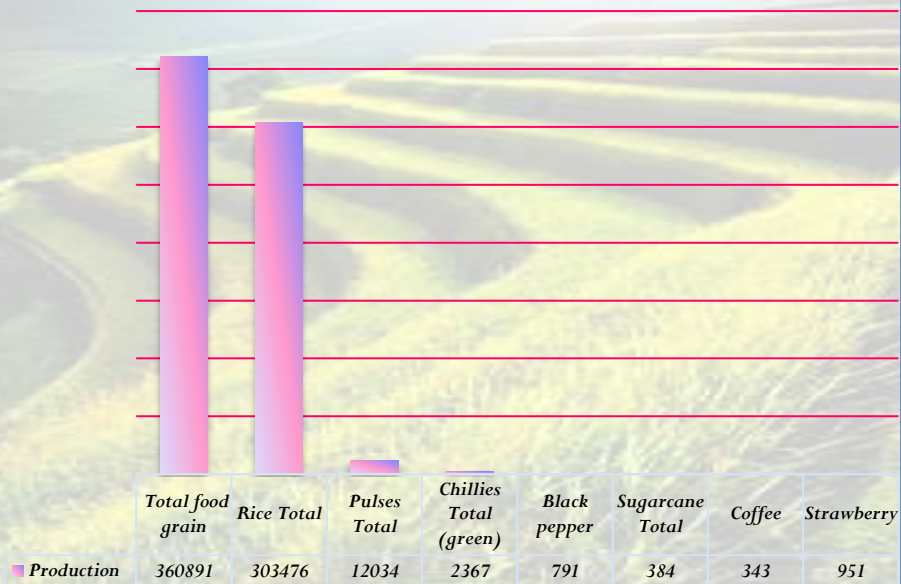
1. Land Classification in Hect. 2018-19



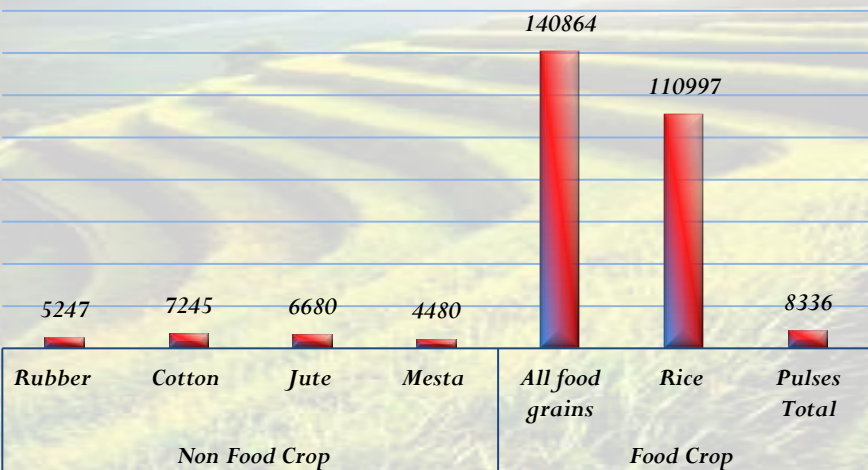
2. Area Under Principal Crop



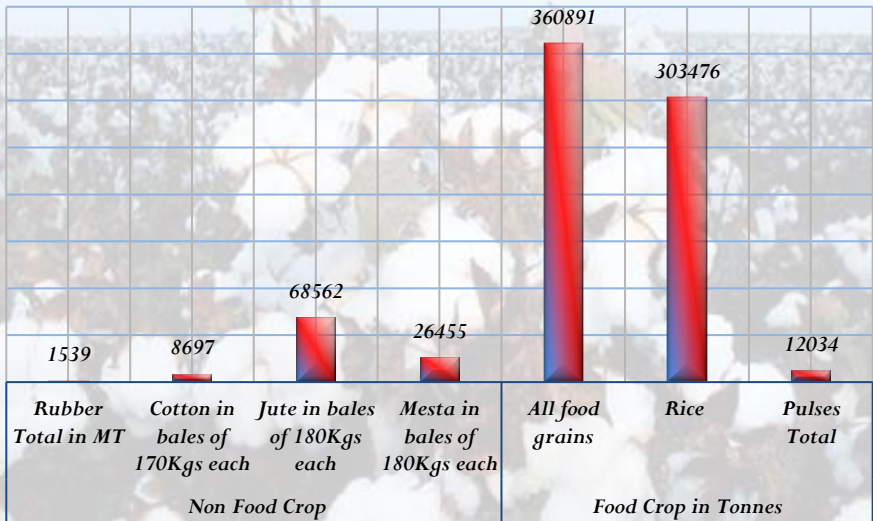
3. Production of Principal Crops in tonnes



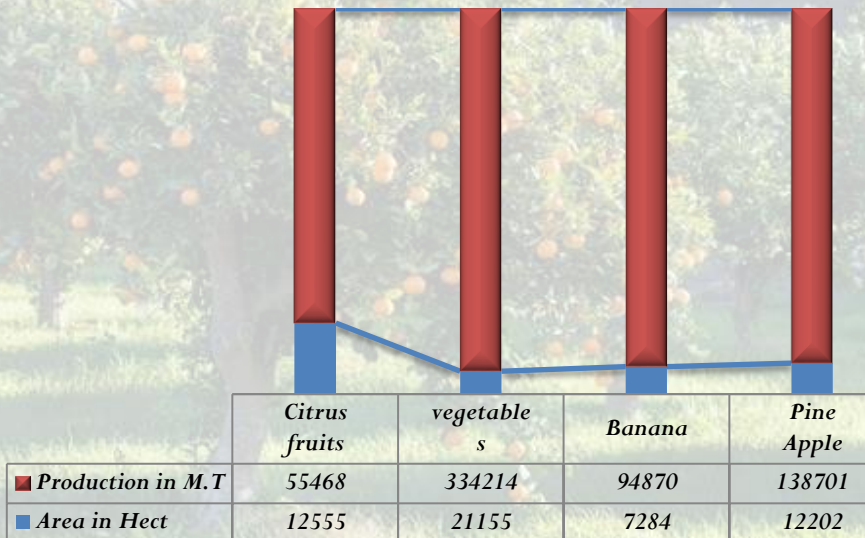

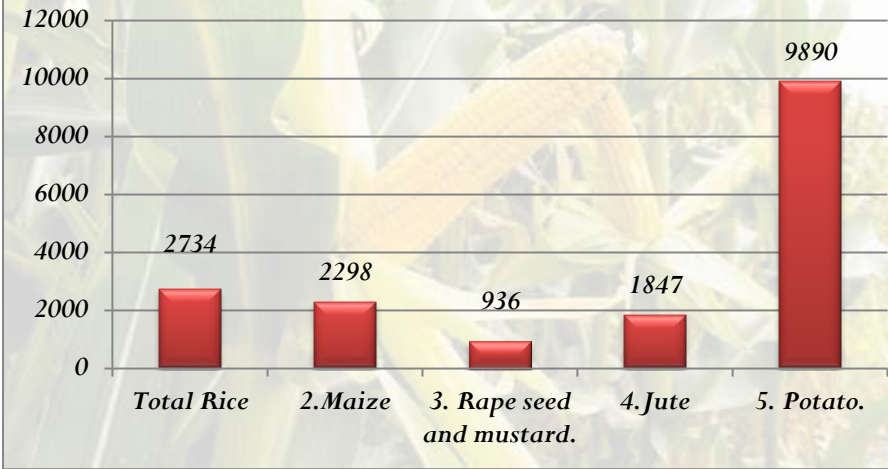

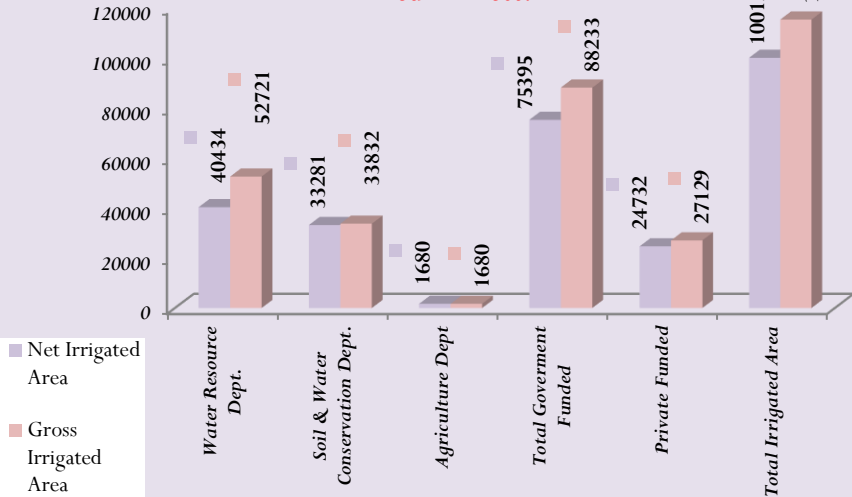
7. Yield Rate Of Some Important Crops in (Kgs /Hectares)

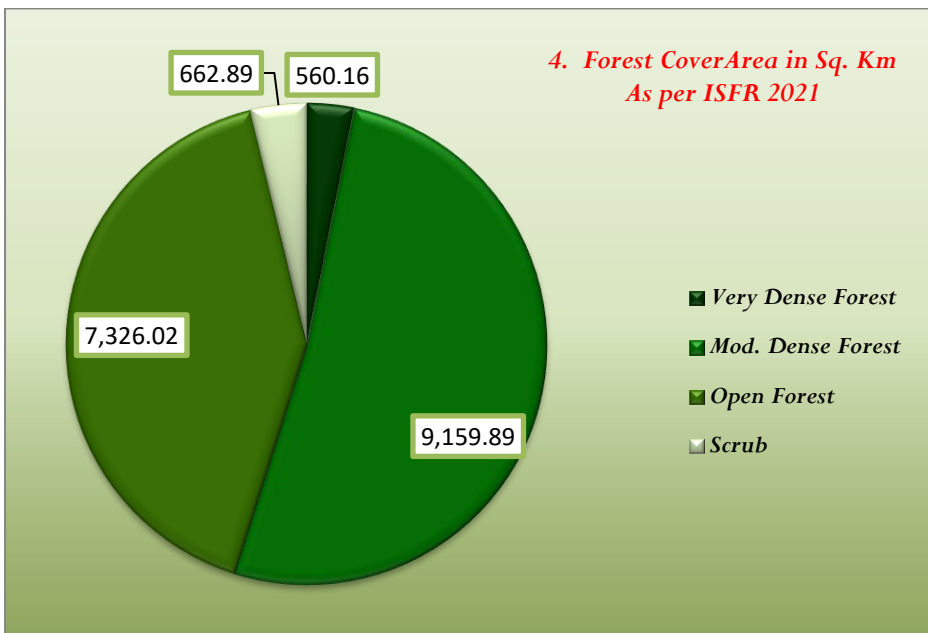

1. PWD Roads in Kms



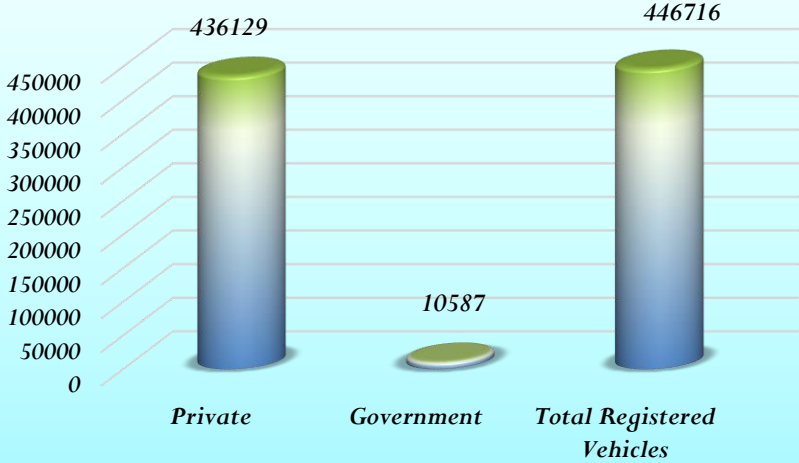
2. Category of Road Length in Kms

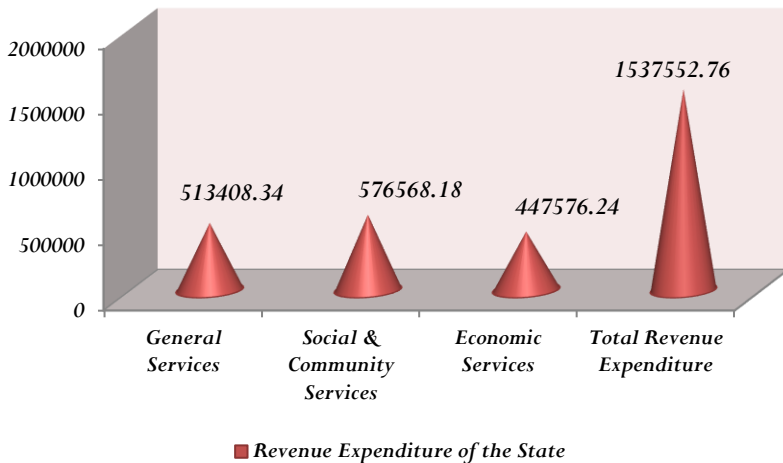

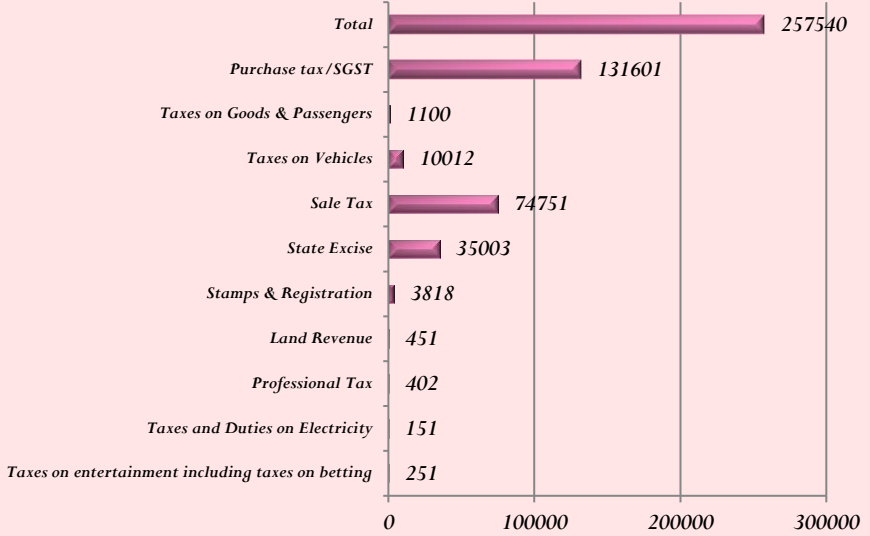

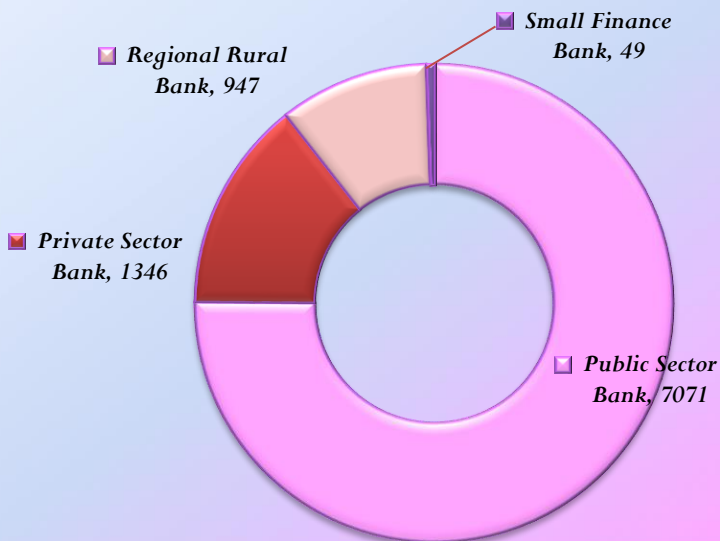

2. Net State Value Added by Economic Activity ₹ in Lakhs

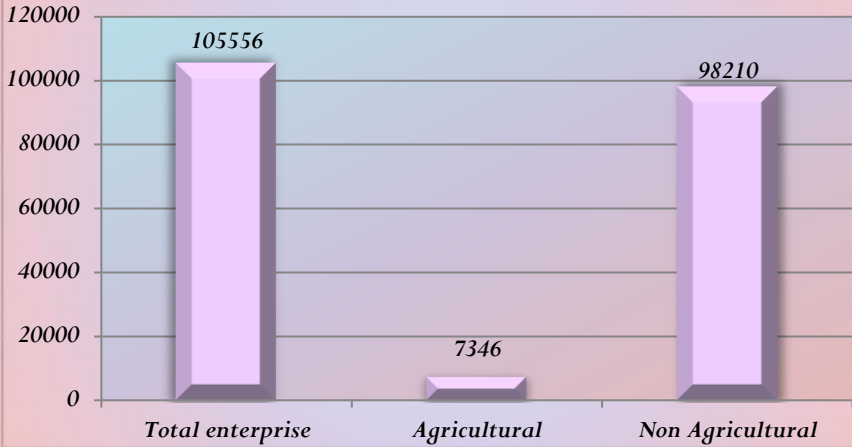




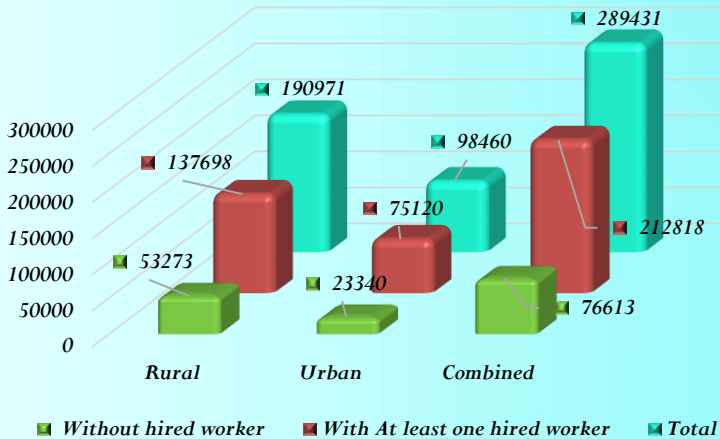

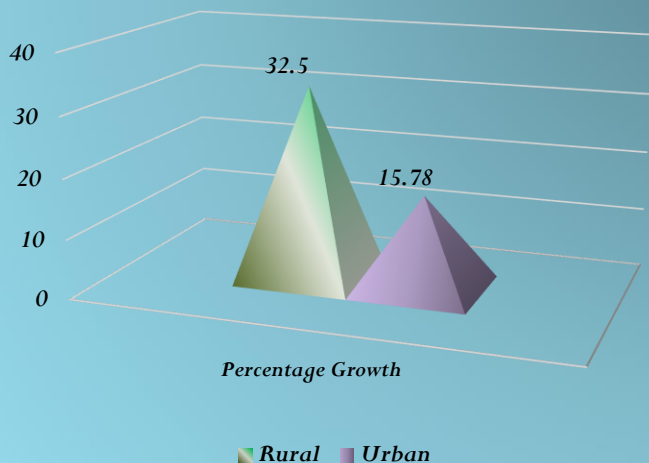
1. No of Enterprise in the State



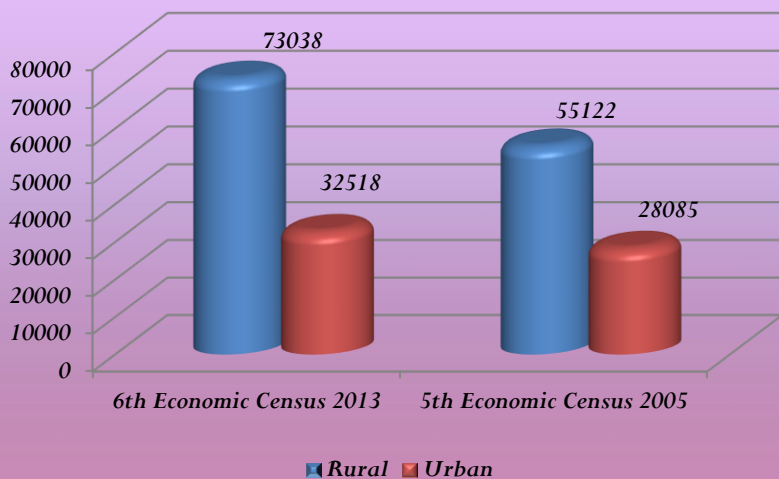
2. Total no of Persons engaged in all broad activity by sector and type
