

The Directorate of Economics and Statistics, Meghalaya, Shillong is the nodal agency of the State Statistical System with the responsibility of collecting, processing and dissemination of Socio-Economic data and information which will be utilized as Economic and Statistical inputs during the process of planning and governance by the Government machineries. The National Sample Survey designed and organized by the National Sample Survey Office (NSSO) is one of the major work programme of the Directorate of Economics and Statistics. The NSS survey programme is being implemented by DES on a regular basis since 1972. The DES is technically aligned and functions in close co-ordination with the NSSO during the conduct of field works and Data processing.
